SMOKY HILL

Smoky Hill is a hard red winter variety developed by WestBred and distributed by AGSECO. Smoky Hill is resistant to stripe rust and leaf rust, and moderately resistant to tan spot and stem rust. It is best adapted to areas north of I-70 in Kansas, all of Nebraska, all of South Dakota and NE Colorado. Its excellent yield potential and disease resistance make it one of the top variety selections in its area of adaptation. Smoky Hill's performance south of I-70 in Kansas has been very good but its relatively late maturity will limit its utilization.
